Classes meet at the Central YMCA on Tuesday and Thursday evenings (7-10) for 5 weeks. Eight ocean dives are completed on Saturday and Sunday of weeks 4 and 5. Total fees for classroom, pool and ocean sessions are \$125 for facility members* (\$200 for non-members).

Students purchase their own personal equipment (mask, snorkel, fins, boots, and gloves) and rent all other equipment. Cost of purchase is approximately \$250. Rental of the other equipment is \$250 total for all pool and ocean sessions.

- Minimum age is 12. Students 12-14 require a parent/guardian be present at all classroom, pool and ocean sessions. 15-17 requires parent/guardian permission.
- Classroom work includes lectures on diving physiology, theory, equipment and safety with time for questions and testing.
- Pool work covers snorkel and SCUBA skills with exercises that build proficiency in the water.

On the first night of class:

- We will cover what you need to know to purchase equipment.
- You will complete a medical history form. A doctor's clearance may be necessary before using SCUBA if you have a medical condition such as asthma or diabetes. Please contact us if you are in doubt.
- You will take a swim test. Bring a swimsuit, towel, goggles (optional) and lock.
